Element of Music: Pitch

Pitch in music means how high or low a note is.

For young children, it will be their ability to identify, sing and match the different pitches they hear.

In the song "The Frog in the Bog", the children will use their fingers to move up and down the arm according to the pitch of the song. This activity aims to develop children's listening skills and at the same time, promotes bilateral coordination.

Let's make a Frog Puppet !



Materials:



Frog Cut-out



Ice-cream
stick



Sticky tape



Safety
scissors

Instructions:

1. Cut the frog cut-out.
2. Paste the ice-cream stick on the back of the frog.
3. Move your frog puppet up and down your arm.
