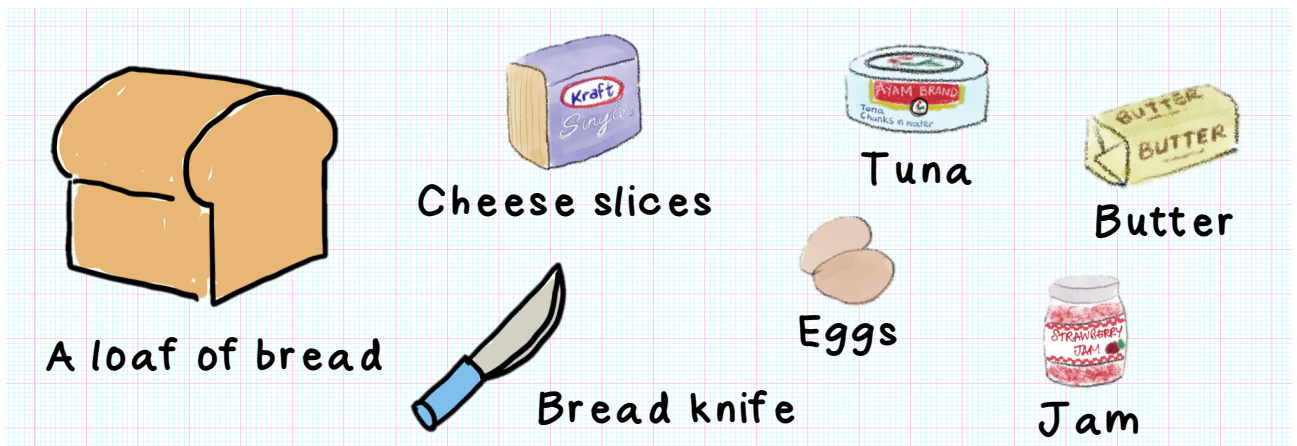




Slice Slice the Bread Looks Nice

Instructions:

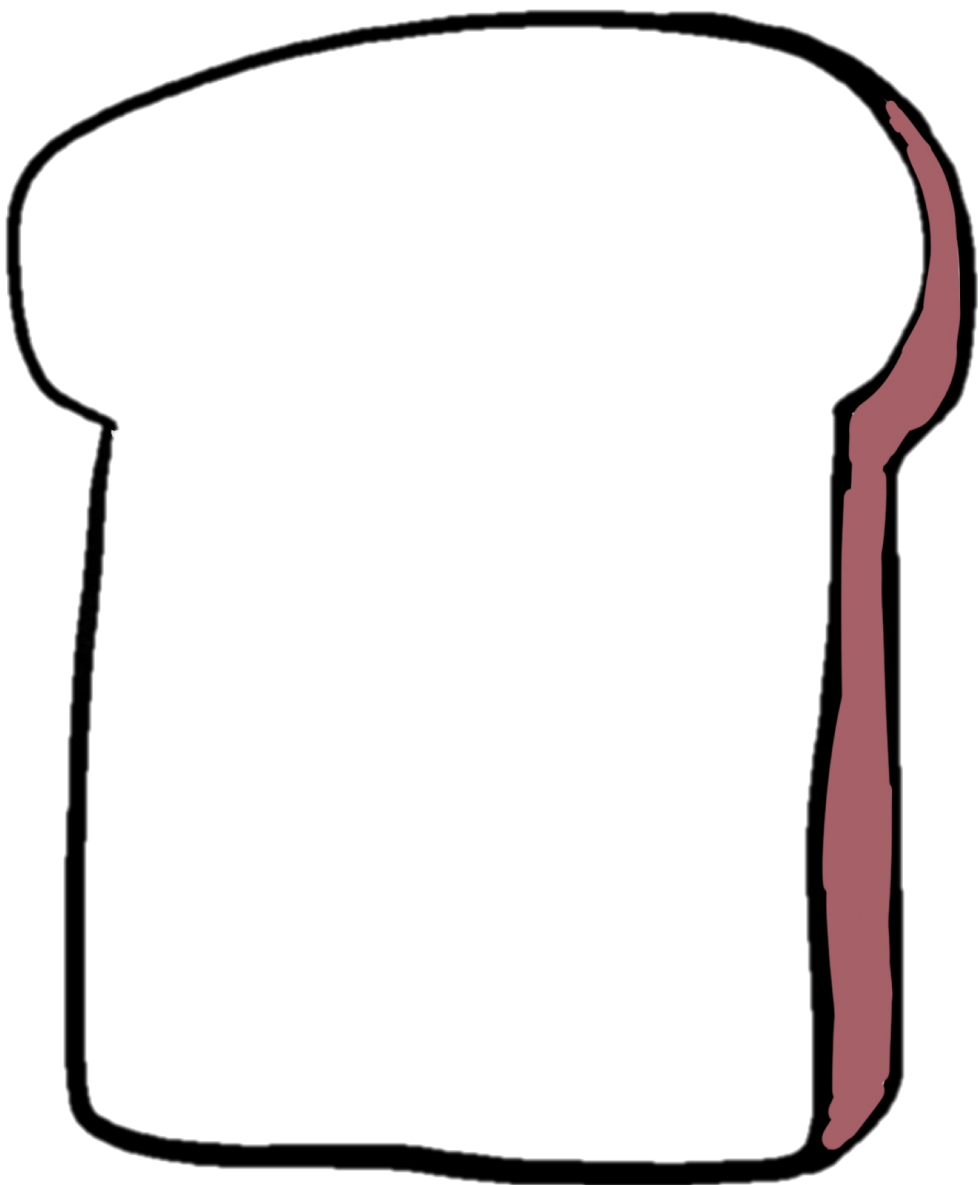
1. Slice the bread with a bread knife.

The Power of Fingerplay
